ORDER:

"Heard.

Sri V.V.Satish, learned counsel for the petitioner in elaboration contended that, though the 2nd respondent has issued proceedings vide R.O.C.No.1950/2015/A1 dated 25.01.2024 for allotment of shops, so far the authorities have not allotted the same. It would suffice if a direction is given to the authorities to consider the petitioner's case in light of the said proceedings dated 25.01.2024.

In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this court is inclined to grant the following interim order:

The respondent authorities are directed to take steps pursuant to the allotment proceedings vide R.O.C.No.1950/2015/A1 dated 25.01.2024, in accordance with law."
