WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri V.V.SATISH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 4th respondent in reopening enquiry by appointing new enquiry officer and issuing notice dated 24-04-2026 to

that effect though the domestic enquiry has already completed and accepted is illegal, arbitrary and violation of Article 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and to consequently set aside the same and further direct the respondents to release pensionary benefits to the petitioner;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V.V.Satish, Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Services-I for Respondent Nos.1 & 3, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted on or before summer vacation, 2026 for which date the case stands posted for hearing;

IA NO: 1 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the orders dated 24.04.2026 passed by the 4th respondent, pending disposal of WP No.12034 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to release the pensioner benefits without referring disciplinary proceedings, pending disposal of WP No.12034 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER:

The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the impugned action of the respondents is not only contrary to the orders passed by this Court in W.P.No.17433 of 2024 dated 28.01.2026 but also contrary to the Andhra Pradesh Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1991 (for short, 'the CCA Rules'). In fact, there is no provision in the CCA Rules contemplating the appointment of a second enquiry officer and the first enquiry officer has conducted an enquiry and submitted a report. After submitting the report, if the respondents are not satisfied with the findings, they may defer by giving separate reasons, but they are not entitled to appoint another enquiry officer.

Considering the said submissions, there shall be stay of all further proceedings pursuant to the notice dated 24.04.2026.

Issue notice to the 4th respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to the 4th respondent by RPAD and file proof of service in the Registry.

List the matter after Summer Vacation, 2026.
