Petition under Sections 482 of Cr.P.C/528 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the Petitioners/A1 and A2 in DVC No.199 of 2025 on the file of 1st Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada, in the interest of Justice., pending disposal of CRLP No. 3630 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Issue notice to Respondent No.2.

The learned Counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The Petitioners are the husband and mother-in-law of Respondent No.2 has lodged a complaint against the Petitioners, which has been registered as Crime No.70 of 2025 on the file of Mahila Urban Police Station, Vijayawada.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Smt.SV Bharatha Lakshmi, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 08.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation.

The learned Magistrate of the trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in D.V.C.No.199 of 2025 on the file of I Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada.
