IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings in FIR No. 52 of 2026 dated 21.04.2026 under sections 196 (1), 352, 353 (1), BNS, 67 ITA- 2000-2008 on the file of the SHO, Cheerla II Town UPS, Bapatla District, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3636 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following order:

“Issue notice to Respondent No.2

The learned Counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Respondent No.2, on an earlier occasion, i.e., on 05.09.2025, lodged a complaint against the Petitioner, which was registered as Crime No.171 of 2025 on the file of Chirala I Town Police Station for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 196(1) and 353(2) of the BNS and Section 67 of the I.T. Act. Subsequently, on 21.04.2026, Respondent No.2 lodged another complaint against the Petitioner on the very same set of allegations, though the dates relating to the alleged cause of action are different. The said complaint has been registered as Crime No.52 of 2026 for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 196(1) and 353(2) of the BNS and Section 67 of the I.T. Act.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Crime No.52 of 2026 on the file of Chirala I Town Police Station, Bapatla District, until the next date of hearing.
