Petition Under Section 528 of B.N.S.S/Old Under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay in all further proceedings in the C.C.No. 48 of 2025 on the file of the Court of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class, At Palasa, including dispensing with personal appearance insofar as the petitioners herein/Accused No.2 to No.3 are concerned and pending disposal of CRLP No. 3660 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

“Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Accused No.1 is the borrower of Respondent No.2, and it appears that he has not repaid the debt amount. Petitioners/Accused Nos.2 and 3 have nothing to do with the said debt.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, and considering the nature of the allegations leveled by Respondent No.2 against the Petitioners, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr.Isukapatla Madhu Babu, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 08.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

The Mediator shall also follow up on the possibility of a one-time settlement of the alleged debt between Accused No.1 and Respondent No.2.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings against the Petitioners/Accused Nos.2 and 3 in

C.C.No.48 of 2025 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Palasa.”
