WHEREAS the Petitioner/Accused above named through their Advocate Sri SHAIK AMEENA REHMANI presented this Petition under Sections 482 of Cr.P.C/528 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the Charge Sheet filed against the Petitioners/Accused No.2 to 4 in SC.No.205/S/2025 on the file of IV Additional

District and Sessions Judge-Cum-Special Court Affiliated for SC, ST Act cases, Guntur registered for offences under Sections 85 BNS, Sections 3 and 4 of DP Act, Section 3(l)(r)(s), 3(2)(va) of .SC, ST, POA Amendment Act, 2015, as they are lacking merits and substance;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri SHAIK AMEENA REHMANI Advocate for the Petitioner, Public Prosecutor for R1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Kanaparthi Deepthi, W/o Pendyala Gopi @ Pendyala Sesha Sai Gopala Krishna, R/o Haridasula Colony, Gundalapadu village, Phirangipuram Mandal. are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted on or before summer vacation, 2026.

Petition under Sections 482 of Cr.P.C/528 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including appearance of the Petitioners/Accused No.2 to 4 in SC.No.205/S/2025 on the file of IV Additional District and Sessions Judge-cum-Special Court affiliated for SC, ST Cases, Guntur registered for offences under Sections 85 BNS, Sections 3 and 4 of DP Act, Section 3(l)(r)(s), 3(2)(va) of .SC, ST, POA Amendment Act, 2015, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3672 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor is permitted to serve the notice contemplated under Section 15A of 'the SC/ST (POA) Act' on Respondent No.2.

The Respondent No.2 and accused No.1 were earlier in love, and subsequently their marriage was solemnized. Respondent No.2 belongs to the Scheduled Caste (Mala) community, while Accused No.1 belongs to the Vysya community.

It appears that after certain misunderstandings arose between them, Respondent No.2 lodged a complaint against the Petitioners alleging commission of offence punishable under Section 498-A of the 'I.P.C.,' offence under the 'the D.P.Act' and also offences under the provisions of 'the SC/ST (POA) Act'.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mrs.Kesavi Kumari Nemala, learned trained mediator is appointed as the mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the learned mediator on 08.05.2026, or on any other convenient to both parties and the mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation- 2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings against the Petitioners/Accused Nos.2 to

4 in S.C.No.205/S/ 2025 on the file of learned IV Additional District and Sessions Judge-cum-Special Court affiliated for SC, ST Cases Guntur.
