WHEREAS the Petitioner/Accused above named through his Advocate Mrs. Sodum Anvesha, presented this Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. & Section 528 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for the records in and relating to S.T.C.No.1919/2025 on the file of the Court of the VII Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class-cum-VII Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Visakhapatnam and quash the same in so far as the Petitioners are concerned;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mrs. Sodum Anvesha, Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to

the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

be and hereby are directed to show cause, either appearing in person or through Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C & Section 528 of BNSS, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including appearance of the Petitioner in S.T.C.No.1919/2025 on the file of the Court of the VII Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class-cum-VII Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Visakhapatnam. pending disposal of CRLP No. 3682 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

THE COURT MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

“Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2

The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Mrs.Sodum Anvesha, the learned counsel for the Petitioner, submits that the Petitioner/Accused No.2 is a Doctor Respondent No.2 was working with him, and there were certain business transactions between the Petitioner and Respondent No.2. Respondent No.2 was in possession of some invalid, undated cheques which were kept for the purpose of easing business transactions. However, Respondent No.2 misused those cheques and foisted a false case against the

Petitioner/Accused No.2. It is further submitted that Accused No.2 is the proprietor of a firm.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. P.Mohan Rao, the learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioner and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 08.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in S.T.C.No. 1919 of 2025 on the file of the learned VII Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class-cum-VII Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Visakhapatnam."

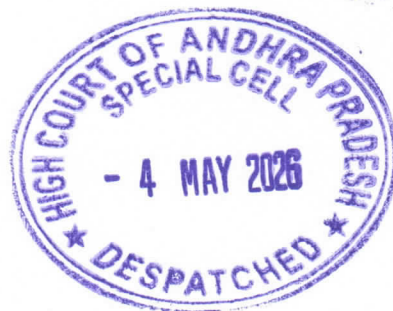
