01.	29.04.2026	<u>Dr.VJP,J</u> <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> Having considered the affidavit filed in support of this application, this Court deems it appropriate to allow this application by condoning the delay of 407 days in filing the Criminal Revision Case. Accordingly, I.A.No.1 of 2025 is allowed. <u>I.A.No. 02 of 2026</u> The present interlocutory application was filed under Section 438 (1) of BNSS, 2023 by the petitioner to suspend the conviction and sentence dated 07.08.2019 passed in S.C.No.301 of 2016 on the file of learned Principal Assistant Sessions Judge, Tirupati, which was confirmed vide Judgment dated 19.11.2024 passed in Crl.A.No.18 of 2022 on the file of learned Judge, Special Court for trial of Cases relating to Red Sanders Smuggling, Tirupati and enlarge the petitioner/accused No.1 on bail, pending disposal of the main Criminal Revision Case. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in jail since	

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		10.03.2026. Upon learning of the dismissal of the appeal, he voluntarily surrendered before the police and is presently undergoing the sentence of conviction. He would further submit that the petitioner is a poor coolie and is unable to pay the fine amount at this juncture. He therefore prays for suspension of the sentence, including the fine. The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that this Hon'ble Court may pass appropriate orders. In view of the submissions made, the sentence of imprisonment alone is suspended, pending disposal of the Criminal Revision Case on the following conditions: i) Presently, the petitioner is undergoing sentence and has been lodged in Jail. The petitioner herein shall be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) with two sureties for the like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned V Additional Judicial Magistrate of I Class, Tirupati. ii) The petitioner shall appear before this Court as and when directed.
