support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for the records relating to and in connection with vide, the FIR in Crime No. 54 of 2026 of Nuzvid Town Police Station, Eluru District, dated 21-03-2026 for the offences punishable under Sections 85 BNS, Section 3 and 4 DP Act consequently quash the same against the petitioners/Accused No.1 to 3.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Abdul Matheen S, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in FIR in Crime No. 54 of 2026 of Nuzvid Town Police Station, Eluru District, dated 21-03-2026 for the offences punishable under Sections 85 BNS, Section 3 and 4 DP Act, Pending disposal of CRLP No.3678 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The marriage between Respondent No.2 and Petitioner No.1/Accused No.1 was solemnized on 09.02.2010. Nearly after 16 years, Respondent No.2, aged about 41 years, has filed a complaint not only against her husband but also against her old aged in-laws.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Ms.Anumula Sudha Varshini, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 08.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.54 of 2026 on the file of Nuzvid Town Police Station, Eluru District.
