The Court made the following:

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE NYAPATHY VIJAY**W.P.No.12144 of 2026****O R D E R:**

1. The present Writ Petition is filed questioning the inaction of Respondents in not implementing the orders issued *vide* G.O.Ms.No.103, Social Welfare Department, dated 19.07.2018, as illegal and arbitrary.

2. The facts in brief are as follows:-

The Petitioner is the owner of a land of an extent of Ac.7.10 Cents situated in R.S.No.105 and 106, Tatiyakulagudem Village, H/o.Buttaigudem Village and Mandal, West Godavari District. The father of the Petitioner namely Andru Ramulu @ Ramarao, purchased the aforesaid land under an agreement of sale, dated 24.06.1969. While so, proceedings under Section 3 of the Andhra Pradesh Scheduled Areas Land Transfer Regulation, 1959 (Regulation No.I of 1959) (for short, the Regulation) were initiated by the competent authority in S.R.No.52/82 and the said

case/application was rejected on 25.02.1983 and ended in favour of the father of the Petitioner and the said proceedings had attained finality.

3. Subsequently, another complaint was filed before the competent authority, and proceedings under Section 3 of the Regulation were initiated against the father of the Petitioner in S.R.No.02/2002, and the same was allowed against the father of the Petitioner. Thereafter, the father of the Petitioner filed an appeal in S.R.A.No.04/2010, which was dismissed on 23.10.2011. Thereafter, the Petitioner filed a revision before the Government and the same was allowed *vide* G.O.Ms.No.103, Social Welfare (T.W.LTR-I) Department, dated 19.07.2018.

4. Thereafter, questioning the orders passed by the revisional authority, W.P.No.33885 of 2018 was filed before this Court by one Kosam Mukkamma and another. The said Writ Petition was dismissed on 30.12.2025 by this Court. It was submitted that no further appeal was filed thereon and the orders passed by this Court have attained finality.

5. Later, Petitioner filed a representation before the District Collector on 07.04.2026 for implementation of the orders passed by the revisional authority *vide* G.O.Ms.No.103, Social Welfare Department, dated 19.07.2018. But no further steps were taken with regard to the representation given by the Petitioner. It was in that context, the present Writ Petition was filed.

6. Learned Assistant Government Pleader submitted that after taking legal advice, an appropriate decision will be taken with regard to the representation given by the Petitioner, as expeditiously as possible.

7. Considering the submissions, this Writ Petition is disposed of, with the following directions:-

(i) The Respondents are directed to examine the representation, dated 07.04.2026 given by the Petitioner, taking note of the orders passed by this Court in W.P.No.33885/2018, dated 30.12.2025.

ii) There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending
in this Petition shall stand closed.
