WHEREAS the Petitioners/Accused above named through their Advocate Sri Suresh Kumar Reddy Kalava presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings against the petitioners in C.C.No.186 of 2022 in the Hon'ble Court of Judicial Magistrate of 1st Class, Jammalamadugu.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Suresh Kumar Reddy Kalava, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause on or before 15.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted either appearing in person or through an advocate as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners, including by dispensing with the presence of the petitioners in C.C. No. 186 of

2022 in the Honble Court of Judicial Magistrate of 1st Class, Jammalamadugu, Pending disposal of CRLP No.3694 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Petitioner No. 1/Accused No.3 is the sister of Accused No.1. Petitioner No.2/Accused No.4 is the husband of Petitioner No.1. Respondent No.2 lodged a complaint before the Station House Officer, Kondapuram Police Station, alleging offences punishable under Sections 494, 114 read with 34 of 'the I.P.C'.

Section 494 of 'the I.P.C.,' enables the jurisdictional Magistrate to convict the husband or spouse who has contracted a second marriage during the subsistence of the first.

Having regard to the allegations leveled against the Petitioner, who has not played any significant role, much less a pivotal role, in convening or solemnizing the marriage between Accused No.1 and a third party, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in respect of the Petitioners/Accused Nos.3 & 4 only in C.C.No.186 of 2022 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Jammalamadugu, until the next date of hearing.

Mr.Mullapudi Satyanarayana, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 08.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.
