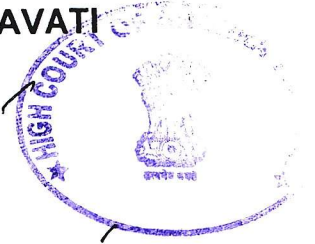

WHEREAS the Petitioner/Accused above named through her Advocate Sri Anjaneya Sarma.M, presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash in C.C.No.1707/2023 arising out of Crime No.780/2022 on the file of the II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada in the interest of justice.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Anjaneya Sarma.M, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in C.C. No. 1707/2023 arising out of Crime No. 780/2022 on the file of the II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada, Pending disposal of CRLP No.3710 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the Petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The Petitioner/Accused No.3 is the sister of Accused No.1 and the sister-in-law of Respondent No.2.

Having regard to the nature of the allegations leveled against the Petitioner by Respondent No.2, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C. No.1707 of 2023 on the file of the learned II Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Vijayawada, until the next date of hearing.

Mrs.Rayudu Sudha, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioner and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 08.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation, 2026, for the Mediator's report.
