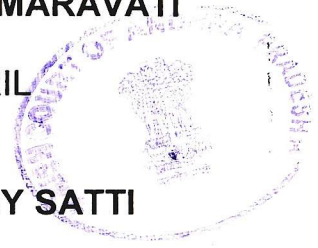

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate Sri P Sai Surya Teja, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of respondent Nos.1 to 3, particularly respondent No.3 Gram Panchayat, in taking action against the illegal and unauthorized commercial construction being undertaken by respondent Nos. 4 and 5 in the agricultural land situated in Survey No.31-1D1 of Vegivada Village, Pedavegi Mandal, Eluru District, without obtaining lawful permissions, land conversion proceedings and statutory approvals, from the 3rd respondent Gram Panchayat, as the same is contrary to law, illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and consequently direct the 3rd respondent, Gram Panchayat to take action against the unauthorized constructions being undertaken by the respondent No. 4 and 5 in accordance with law by considering the representation of the petitioners dated 18-04-2026

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P Sai Surya Teja, Advocate for the Petitioners, and of GP for Panchayat raj for Respondent No.1, and of GP for Revenue for Respondent No.2, and of Sri Y.Koteswara Rao, Standing Counsel for Respondent No.3, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.4 & 5 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause on or before 15.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted either appearing in person or through an advocate as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 3 respondent, Gram Panchayat to take action against the unauthorized constructions being undertaken by the respondent No. 4 and 5 in the agricultural land situated in Survey No.31-1D1 of Vegivada Village, Pedavegi Mandal, Eluru District, in accordance with law by considering the representation of the petitioners dated 18-04-2026, Pending disposal of WP No.12294 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Government Pleader for Panchayat Raj takes notice for respondent No.1.

Learned Government Pleader for Revenue takes notice for respondent No.2.

Sri Y. Koteswara Rao, learned standing counsel takes notice, offers to file vakalat for respondent No.3 and seeks time to get instructions.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondents 4 and 5 through speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

The above writ petition is filed to declare the inaction of respondent No.3 in taking action against the illegal and unauthorized commercial construction undertaken by respondents 4 and 5 in survey No.31-1D1 of Vegivada Village, Pedavegi Mandal, Eluru District, without obtaining permission from respondent No.3, as illegal and arbitrary.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 would submit that pursuant to the complaint, dated 18.04.2026 and letter dated 22.04.2026 addressed by the Eluru Urban Development Authority, a notice, dated 23.04.2026 was issued to respondent No.5 and respondent No.5 stopped the construction.

The above submission of learned counsel for respondent No.3 is recorded.
