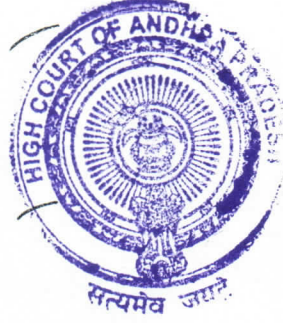

You are further directed that if the said respondent furnishes personal bond for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum with an undertaking affidavit that he will appear before this Court on 20.02.2026, he may be released on bail subject to the condition that he shall attend this Court on 20.02.2026 and shall continue to attend this Court until otherwise directed.

You are also further directed to return this warrant as early as possible preferably on or before 20.02.2026 to this Court with a detailed report stating the manner in which it has been executed.
