WHEREAS the Petitioners/Accused above named through their Advocate SRI P NAGENDRA REDDY presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the

FIR No.24/2026 on the file of II Town Police Station, Guntakal Anantapuramu District in the interest of justice. .

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri P NAGENDRA REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, Public Prosecutor for the Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this **CRIMINAL PETITION** should not be admitted.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of further proceedings to the extent of the petitioners in FIR No.24/2026 pending on the file of II Town Police Station, Guntakal Anantapuramu District, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3724 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following order:

“Heard learned counsel for Petitioners and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

The Respondent No.2 alleges that the Petitioners have committed the offences of criminal breach of trust and cheating besides bigamy.

The Petitioner No.1 is the alleged second wife of Accused No.1

The Hon'ble Apex Court in Delhi Race Club (1940) Ltd v. State of Uttar Pradesh¹ observed that the criminal breach of trust and cheating cannot go together.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Sri Unnava Nagaraju, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 08.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator, and shall co-operate with the mediation.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in FIR No.24 of 2026 of II Town Police Station, Guntakal."
