The learned Advocate General appearing for the respondents submitted that the respondents have already paid the minimum time scale to the petitioner(s) and, therefore, no further amount is payable. He further submitted that the respondents are ready to implement the directions issued by the learned Single Judge in W.P.No.33089 of 2010 in paragraph No. 22 of the impugned order by extending the benefit of the minimum time scale. The learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner/appellant, on the other hand, submitted that the respondents have not implemented the orders passed by this Court. It is contended that the petitioner is entitled to receive the minimum time scale with effect from the date of the interim order passed by this Court. Both the learned counsel requested short time to file calculation memos with regard to the amount payable to the petitioners.
