The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect. The Respondent No.2 has filed a complaint under Section 138 of 'the N.I.Act', which was registered as a case in C.C. No.625 of 2024. The Respondent No.2 has also filed a criminal case, which was registered as FIR No.15 of 2025 for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 318(4), 351(2), and 351(3) of 'the BNS', and Section 175(3) of 'the BNSS', by way of filing a private complaint before the learned Jurisdictional Magistrate, which was forwarded to the Station House Officer, Jaggayyapet, under Section 173(3) of 'the BNSS' for registration and investigation. Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.15 of 2025 on the file of Jaggaiahpet Police Station, until the next date of	Contd...

hearing.

The matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. Mastan Vali Shaik, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.
