are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CriminalPetition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in FIR.No. 15/2025 on the file of the Jaggaiahpet Police Station, NTR District pending disposal of the above CrI.P. in the interest of Justice;

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The Respondent No.2 has filed a complaint under Section 138 of 'the N.I.Act', which was registered as a case in C.C. No.625 of 2024. The

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Respondent No.2 has also filed a criminal case, which was registered as FIR No.15 of 2025 for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 318(4), 351(2), and 351(3) of 'the BNS', and Section 175(3) of 'the BNSS', by way of filing a private complaint before the learned Jurisdictional Magistrate, which was forwarded to the Station House Officer, Jaggayyapet, under Section 173(3) of 'the BNSS' for registration and investigation.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in Cr.No.15 of 2025 on the file of Jaggaiahpet Police Station, until the next date of hearing.

The matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. Mastan Vali Shaik, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

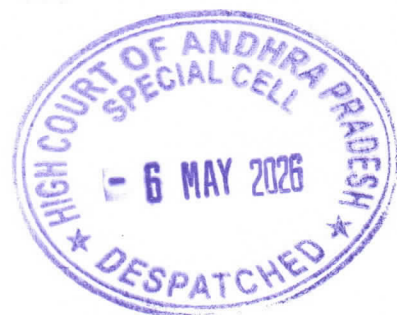
