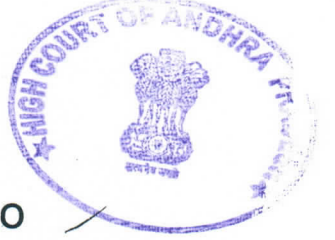

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to Respondent No.2.

The learned Counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The Petitioners are the aged parents-in-law and sister-in-law of Respondent No.2. The Respondent No.2 has lodged a complaint not only against her husband but also against her aged parents-in-law and sister-in-law.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Sri Vadapalli Ramesh, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The Petitioners and Respondent No.2 shall appear before the mediator on 08.05.2026, or on any other date convenient to both parties and the mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the learned trained mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.207 of 2026 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tadipathri, Ananthapuram District.
