WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri. G L NAGESWAR RAO, presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to call for records in connection with the case in C.C.No.208 of 2018 on the file of Special Magistrate, Amalapuram, East Godavari District, which was taken on file for the alleged offences under section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and to quash the same against the petitioner herein as it is illegal, arbitrary, unjust

and abuse of process of law and the allegations do not attract the ingredients of the alleged offences;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri G L NAGESWAR RAO, Advocate for the Petitioner and of PUBLIC PROSECUTOR, for the Respondent No.2, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.1, herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS., is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CriminalPetition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in connection with the case in C.C.No.208 of 2018 on the file of Special Magistrate, Amalapuram, East Godavari District in the interest of justice;

The Court made the following ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.1.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.1 and file proof to that effect.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, by virtue of an agreement between Respondent No.1 and the petitioner, the petitioner has paid the amount; however, Respondent No.1 has instituted a complaint under Section 138 of 'the N.I. Act'.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr.R.V.Surendranath Varma, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No.1 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The learned Magistrate of the Trial Court and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for Mediator's report.

Until the conclusion of the mediation proceedings, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.208 of 2018 on the file of the learned Special Magistrate, Amalapuram, East Godavari District.
