WHEREAS the Petitioner/Accused above named through his Advocate MS. NEELA MANJARI J S presented this Petition under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to Quash against Crime No (HR No.38/2026 dated 22-04-2026 Under Section 61 (2), 338,336,340(2), 318(4), 351 (2) R/W 3(5) OF B.N.S of P.S. Durgi, New Palnadu District against the petitioners/ accused No.5

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of MS. NEELA MANJARI J S Advocate for the Petitioner, ASSISTANT PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are be and hereby directed to show cause either appearing in person or through an Advocate, as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this **CRIMINAL PETITION** should not be admitted.

IA NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to issue directions not to arrest the petitioners/ accused No.5 and also not to call him for police station during the investigations of this case. Since the entire crime related to the loan sanction of Rs.6,50,000/- by APTUS Finance Company, Piduguralla, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3772 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following order:

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The alleged offences levelled against the Petitioner/Accused are punishable with imprisonment for less than seven (07) years.

In the meanwhile, the Investigating Officer is directed to comply with the guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court in *Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar*¹, and also with the provisions of Section 35(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for brevity, 'the BNSS'). However, the petitioner is directed to cooperate with the Investigating Officer, and the Investigating Officer may proceed with the further investigation. In the course of investigation, if it is noticed that the petitioner has committed any offence punishable with imprisonment beyond seven years, the Investigating Officer is at liberty to proceed in accordance with law.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Mr. Ramachandra Reddy Uppada, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The petitioner and Respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the learned Mediator on 08.05.2026 or on any other convenient date for the parties and the Mediator.

The Station House Officer concerned is hereby directed to secure the presence of the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report."
