AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri O UDAYA KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioner, ASSISTANT PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure code/ Section 528 of BNSS is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the Petitioners/Accused Nos. 2, 7, 8 and 9 in Private Complaint in C.C.No.Of 2025 in C.F.No. 5195 of 2025 on the file of IV Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Chittoor, Chittoor

District in the interest of Justice., pending disposal of CRLP No. 3782 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following order:

“Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

The Respondent No.2, in addition to lodging a complaint before the police, which was registered as a case in Crime No.65 of 2025 of Chittoor I Town Police Station for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 318(2), 319(2), 125, 61(2)(a), 49 read with 3(5), and 88 read with 52 of ‘the BNS’, and Sections 23 and 25 of the Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act, 1994, has also filed a complaint under Section 223 of ‘the BNSS.,’ before the Jurisdictional Magistrate.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case, there shall be a stay of all further proceedings in C.F.No.5195 of 2025 on the file of the IV Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Chittoor, until further orders.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026.”
