Podili P.S., Markapuram District, which was registered for the alleged offences under sections 318(2), 351(2), 61(2) of BNS and to quash the same against the petitioners/Accused Nos.10 & 11 herein as it is

illegal, arbitrary, unjust and abuse of process of law and the allegations do not attract the ingredients of the alleged offences;

The petitioners/Accused Nos.10 and 11 are public servants working as Sub-Registrars. The Respondent No.2 has raised certain allegations against the private parties as well as against the petitioners.

Having regard to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, the Investigating Officer is directed not to take any coercive steps against the petitioners/Accused Nos.10 and 11.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026.
