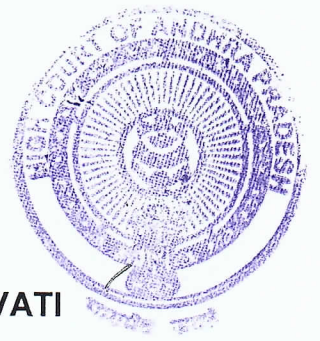

ORDER:

“Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that the petitioner is a daily wage labour living with her husband and other family members, her husband works as RTC Driver and they have no e-mail ID. He further submits that the impugned assessment order has been passed in violation of the principles of natural justice.

Considering the submissions made, there shall be a direction to the respondents not to take any coercive action pursuant to the impugned order dated 21.03.2025 for a period of eight (08) weeks.”
