ORDER:

When this appeal is taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the respondent brought to the notice of this Court that, despite the orders of this Court permitting the respondent to withdraw the amount deposited pursuant to the orders dated 30.08.2010, the respondent has been unable to withdraw the same, as the particulars relating to such deposit are not available with the concerned Court.

It is submitted that an amount of Rs.5,38,037/- was deposited by the learned Government Pleader for Appeals, pursuant to the orders of this Court dated 30.08.2010, by way of Demand Draft No.330455 drawn on State Bank of India, Repalle, in the name of the II Additional Senior Civil Judge, Guntur (FTC), towards half of the decretal amount payable to the decree-holder in O.S. No. 71 of 1995.

Registrar (Judicial) is directed to obtain necessary information from the learned Court of the II Additional Senior Civil Judge, Guntur (FTC), regarding the credit and deposit of the aforesaid amount of Rs.5,38,037/- in O.S. No.71 of 1995, and place the same before this Court.

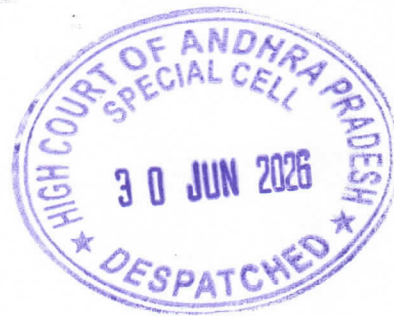
