The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the earlier orders of the High Court dated: 30.08.2010 , 24.12.2025 & 24.06.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of GP FOR APPEALS for the Petitioners and of Sri S V S CHOWDARY, Advocate for the Respondent and the Court made the following;

ORDER:

“The information received from the Court of II Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Guntur, *vide* letter dated 01.07.2026, reads as under:

“...The appellants in the aforementioned A.S.No.29 of 2009 have deposited a sum of Rs.5,38,037/- (Rupees Five Lakh Thirty-Eight Thousand Thirty-Seven only) on 06.05.2011. This deposit was made by way of Demand Draft (D.D) bearing No.330455 dated 15.04.2011.

The said amount remains lying to the credit of O.S.No.71 of 1995 on the file of the II Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division) (FTC), Guntur”.

2. It appears that the amount is lying to the credit of O.S.No.71 of 1995, but not by way of fixed deposit.
3. The learned Principal District Judge, Guntur, is requested to verify whether there are any similar instances in the District where amounts deposited to the credit of judicial proceedings have not been invested in Fixed Deposits in accordance with the Circular Instructions issued by this Hon'ble High Court, and to take appropriate remedial measures, wherever necessary.
4. The Registrar (Judicial) is directed to obtain a report from the learned Principal District Judge, Guntur District regarding the above.
