ORDER:

The Criminal Petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'the Cr.P.C.)/Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for brevity, 'the BNSS'), seeking to quash the docket order dated 28.04.2026 passed by the learned Judicial First Class Magistrate, Allagadda, whereby a Non-Bailable Warrant was issued against the petitioner.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

3. The petitioner is working as an Advocate in the Allagadda Courts. The petitioner was not present before the learned Trial Court on 28.04.2026, and a Non-Bailable Warrant was issued against him. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case has been pending for trial for the past six years.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, if one more opportunity had been granted to the petitioner, the ends of justice would have been served. Hence, the Non-Bailable Warrant issued on 28.04.2026 by the learned Judicial First Class Magistrate, Allagadda, against the petitioner is hereby recalled, subject to the condition that the

petitioner shall appear before the learned Magistrate on the next date of hearing, i.e., 08.05.2026, without fail.

5. In the result, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

As a sequel, Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, shall stand closed.
