Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS, declaring the action of the respondents in not issuing the D Form Patta in favor of the petitioners under Board Standing

Orders and also not issuing the Pattadar Pass Book and Title Deed in respect of the land in Sy.No. 263/3, 263/4 to an extent of Ac. 2.50 cents in each survey number total Ac. 5.00 cents situated at Illuru Village, Garladinne Mandal, Anantapur District though the petitioners are cultivating the said land since 1979 as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and violative of Board Standing Orders 0 15-P-3 (iii) and also violative of Art. 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to issue D Form Patta, Pattadar Pass Book and Title Deed under Rights in Land and Pattadar Pass Book Act, 1971 and Rules made there under and pass

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Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to DIRECT the respondents not to dispossess the petitioners from the land in Sy.No. 263/3 & 263/4 to an extent of Ac. 2.50 cents in each survey number total Ac. 5.00 cents situated at Illuru Village, Garladinne Mandal, Anantapur District, pending disposal of above writ petition and pass

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue furnished written instructions received from the Tahsildar-4th respondent *vide* Rc.No.B/128/2026 dated 06.04.2026, and submitted that in pursuance of the interim order dated 07.08.2019, the respondents issued pattadar passbooks in respect of the land in Sy.Nos.263/3 and 263/4 to an extent of Acs.2.50 cents in each survey number, situated at Illuru Village, Garladinne Mandal, Anantapur District.

3. In view of the above, this Court is of the opinion that no further orders are required in this writ petition.

4. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is closed. No costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.
