Narasapuram Mandal of Eluru District as illegal, irrational, irregular, without jurisdiction and violative of principles of Natural Justice, provisions of Andhra Pradesh Rights in Land and Pattadar Pass Books Act, 1971 and offends articles 14, 21 and 300A of Constitution of India and consequential direct the respondents not to interfere in any manner with my possession over my said land.
