

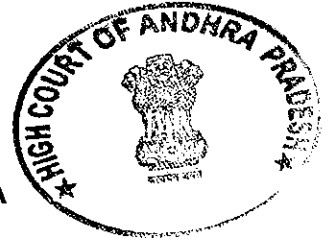

WHEREAS, the Petitioner has presented under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of courts Act 1971, the above case through his Counsel Sri M.R.Tagore, praying that this Hon'ble High Court may be pleased to punish the Respondents herein for willfull violation of the final orders of this Hon'ble Court passed in W.P. No. 19104/2025 dated 17-12-2025.

WHEREAS, the said case coming on for orders as to admission on this day and whereas the High Court, upon perusing the affidavit filed therein and the earlier orders of the High Court dated 08.05.2026, 29.06.2026 &

07.07.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri M.R.Tagore, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Sri G.Raju, Advocate for the Respondent Nos.1, 3 & 4, and of Sri Nagaraju Pullagura, Advocate for the Respondent No.2, the Court made the following

ORDER:

“Heard Mr.M.R.Tagore, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr.G.Raju, learned counsel for respondent Nos.1, 3 and 4, and Mr.P.Nagaraju, learned counsel for respondent No.2.

Mr.G.Raju, learned counsel for respondent Nos.1, 3 and 4, after going through the docket order, dated 07.07.2026, would submit that if the particulars of the petitioner and the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner are put in by way of an affidavit, the same would be considered and appropriate orders would be passed according to the averments in the said affidavit.

Mr.G.Raju, learned counsel, would further submit that the respondent No.4 was under the impression that the speaking order was issued according to G.O.Ms.No.114, dated 21.10.2023. But G.O.Ms.No.114 is nothing but a consequential order to Andhra Pradesh Regularization of Services of Contract Employees Act, 2023 (Act No.30 of 2023), dated 20.10.2023, which entails contract employees for regularization.

Mr.P.Nagaraju, learned counsel for the respondent No.2, has marked his arguments, stating that as per the directions, they have issued instructions to the concerned authorities and are awaiting further instructions.

As per the directions of this Court, respondent No.4, Dr.A.Naga Sashibhusan Reddy, is present before the Court.

Mr.M.R.Tagore, learned counsel for the petitioner, is directed to file an affidavit containing all the aspects of the petitioner by one week and

the same to be served on Mr.G.Raju, learned counsel for respondent Nos.1, 3 and 4.

Post the matter on 29.07.2026.

The appearance of the respondent No.4 is dispensed with."
