The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V R Reddy Kovvuri, Advocate for the Petitioner, and of Public Prosecutor for the Respondent No.1, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Since the alleged offences are compoundable in nature, the matter is referred to mediation. Sri CH. Veera Venkata Satyanarayana, learned trained Mediator, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The learned Trial Court Magistrate and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, the presence of Petitioner/Accused No.2, who is a student, is dispensed with before the learned Trial Court, unless his presence is otherwise required.
