IA NO: 1 OF 2026:

Petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds of criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings in D.V.C. No. 301 of 2024 before the I Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, at Vijayawada against the Petitioners herein, pending disposal of CRLP No.3943 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

Issue notice to the Respondent No.2.

The learned Counsel for the Petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to Respondent No.2 and file proof to that effect.

Respondent No.2 has filed a complaint against the Petitioners and other relatives for the alleged offences punishable under Section 498-A of the IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of the DP Act, which was registered as Crime No.69 of 2024. Respondent No.2 has also filed a maintenance case against her husband, which is registered as F.C.O.P. M.C. No. 1082 of 2024 on the file of the learned Principal Family Court-cum-IV Additional District Court, Vijayawada.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the matter is referred to mediation.

Sri Hemalatha Minchala, is appointed as the Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The learned Trial Court Magistrate and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, the presence of the Petitioners/Accused Nos. 1 and 2 is dispensed with before the learned Trial Court unless their presence is otherwise required.
