5.	20.07.2026	<u>RNT, J & PKC, J</u> The petitioner, the sister of the detenu, namely, Devarakonda Sudheer @ Ajay Reddy, S/o Late Ravi Kumar, aged about 43 years, resident of Thuffan Nagar, Kavali Town, SPSR Nellore District, has filed the present writ petition seeking to set aside the preventive detention order passed in Rc.C1(MagI)/45/2026, dated 16.04.2026, as confirmed by the State Government vide G.O.Rt.No.841, General Administration (SC-I) Department, dated 24.04.2026, and consequently to set free the detenu. 2. I.A.No.3 of 2026 has been filed seeking temporary release/interim bail, of the detenu for a period of thirty (30) days by suspending the operation of the detention order and the confirmation order. 3. It is stated in the affidavit filed in support of the application that the detenu has the only son, and that a male child was born to that son on 05.06.2026. Unfortunately, the child, who is the only grandson in the family, passed away on 12.07.2026. On account of the said unfortunate incident, temporary release of the detenu has been sought to enable him to be with his family. Documents in support of the above averments have been filed along with the affidavit. 4. Learned Government Pleader, on instructions obtained pursuant to the order dated	

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		15.07.2026, submits that the factum of the death of the detenu's grandson is not in dispute. 5. The petitioner has undertaken in the affidavit that the detenu shall surrender before the Superintendent, Central Prison, YSR Kadapa, immediately on expiry of the period of temporary release and shall abide by all the conditions that may be imposed. 6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are 21 criminal cases registered against the detenu and he has already been granted bail in all those cases. 7. Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, particularly the death of the detenu's grandson, which is not disputed by the respondents, we are inclined to grant temporary release to the detenu for a limited period, subject to the conditions. 8. Accordingly, I.A.No.3 of 2026 is allowed. The detenu, Devarakonda Sudheer @ Ajay Reddy, aged about 43 years, shall be temporarily released for a period of ten (10) days, from 22.07.2026 to 31.07.2026 (both days inclusive), provided he is not required in connection with any other case, subject to the following conditions: <i>1. The detenu shall execute a self-bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties for the like sum each to the satisfaction of the Superintendent, Central Prison, YSR</i>	

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		<i>Kadapa.</i> 2. <i>The detenu shall not involve himself in any criminal activity or indulge in any act prejudicial to the maintenance of public order during the period of temporary release.</i> 3. <i>The detenu shall not leave the jurisdiction of the detaining authority without his prior permission.</i> 4. <i>The detenu shall surrender passport, if any, to the concerned Station House Officer.</i> 5. <i>The detenu shall surrender before the Superintendent, Central Prison, YSR Kadapa District, on or before 5.00 p.m. on 31.07.2026, without fail,</i> 6. <i>The detenu shall submit an undertaking before the Superintendent, Central Prison, YSR Kadapa, to the above effect as in Clause Nos.2 to 5 (supra).</i> 9. The period of temporary release of ten (10) days (from 22.07.2026 till 31.07.2026) shall have to be undergone by the detenu, so as to complete the period of detention under the impugned order, subject to the final orders in the writ petition. 10. List on 10.08.2026.
