Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondent Nos.5 and 4 in respectively opening and maintaining the Rowdy Sheet against the petitioner and thereby disturbing the personal liberty of petitioner as arbitrary, illegal and

violation of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to close the Rowdy Sheet against the petitioner pending in the 4th respondent police station in the interest of justice.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to summon the petitioner to the police station on the ground of pendency of the Rowdy Sheet in the 4th respondent police station, Pending disposal of WP 13328 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI Y BHANUSRI AKHILA, Advocate for the Petitioner, learned GP FOR HOME for the Respondent Nos.1 to 5, the Court made the following

ORDER:

“Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioner.

At request of the learned Assistant Government Pleader, post the matter after four (04) weeks.

In the meanwhile, the respondent authorities shall follow the procedure directed by the Hon’ble Division bench of this Court in its order dated 12.09.2022 in I.A.No.01 of 2022 in Writ Appeal No.674 of 2022, for summoning the Petitioner to the police station on account of the pending suspect sheet.”
