Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., and 528 of BNSS Act, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition,

the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the petitioners/accused No. 2 & 3 in C.C. No.3779 of 2025 on the file of the VIth Additional Judicial Magistrate of 1st Class Guntur, pending disposal of CRLP 3949 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Y.Subba Rao, Advocate for the Petitioners and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1, the Court made the following

ORDER:

“Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

The Petitioners are the mother-in-law and the sister-in-law of the Respondent No.2. There are sweeping allegations levelled by the Respondent No.2 against the Petitioners.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the alleged offences are compoundable in nature. Therefore, the matter is referred to mediation.

Smt. Hemalatha Minchala, learned trained Mediator is appointed as Mediator in this case.

The Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee, is directed to issue necessary proceedings in that regard.

The fee for the Mediator shall be fixed at a later point of time.

The learned Trial Court Magistrate and the Station House Officer concerned are hereby directed to drive the parties before the Mediator for amicable settlement.

Post the matter after Summer Vacation-2026, for the Mediator's report.

Until the mediation proceedings are concluded, there shall be stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.3779 of 2025 on the file of learned VI Additional Judicial Magistrate of I Class, Guntur.”
