WHEREAS the Petitioner has presented under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act 1971, above case through his counsel Sri V.Vinod K.Reddy, praying the High Court to punish the Respondents for the violation of the order in W.P.No.18151 of 2012 dated 25.11.2024;

WHEREAS the said case coming on for hearing on this day and whereas the High Court upon perusing the affidavit filed herein and the order of High Court dated 17.06.2025 made herein and upon hearing the arguments

of Sri V.Vinod K.Reddy, Advocate for the Petitioner, the Court made the following

ORDER:

“Notice issued to 1st respondent returned unserved and other respondents are served.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that 1st respondent is not a necessary party to this contempt case.

Smt. Sushma Yaganti, learned counsel, entered appearance for respondent Nos.2 to 4. However, today, there is no representation on their behalf, despite the matter being passed over and called again.

The present contempt case is filed alleging willful disobedience on the part of respondents in complying with the order dated 25.11.2024 passed by this Court in W.P.No.18151 of 2012, whereby, while allowing the said writ petition, this Court has issued the following directions:

“25. In view of the above findings, the writ petition succeeds and the same is accordingly allowed. The respondents 1 to 4 are directed to pay compensation equivalent to the market value of the land and extend other benefits to the extent of lands mentioned as below as per the provisions of Land Acquisition Act, 1894, as if he is the owner of the subject land, situated at Appaiahpalem Village, Satyavedu Mandal, Chittoor District.

The aforesaid exercise shall be completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs."

Though specific time limit of three months was provided for the respondents to complete the exercise and pay compensation to the petitioner, it is sated that the order has not been implemented so far.

In view of the same, the contempt case is admitted as against respondent Nos.2 to 4.

Herein fail not.

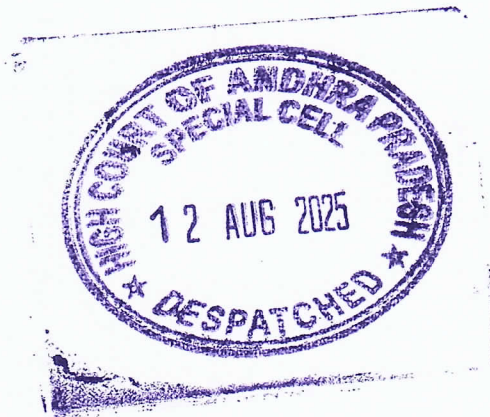
