Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased topleased It is therefore prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue any appropriate Writ, order, direction, more particularly one in the nature of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in not paying compensation to the Petitioner for the land acquired in R.S. No. 332/P at Madhurawada Village, Chinnagadili Mandal, Visakhapatnam District admeasuring to an extent of Ac. 2.27 Acres in view of the orders of this Hon'ble Court in W.P. No. 14209 of 2011 dated 24.08.2017 and thereby not considering the representation of the Petitioner dated 20.02.2025, 11.02.2025, and 29.11.2024 for the same as being illegal, arbitrary, and violative to Article 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of Indian Constitution and consequently, direct the Respondents to pay compensation for the land acquired in R.S. No. 332/P at Madhurawada Village, Chinnagadili Mandal, Visakhapatnam District admeasuring to an extent of Ac. 2.27 Acres in terms of orders of this Hon'ble Court in W.P. No. 14209 of 2011 dated 24.08.2017 and pass
