Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any writ, order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in withholding the payment of bills amount of Rs.7,93,194/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Ninety Three Thousand One Hundred and Ninety Four only) even after finalizing the bills payable to the Petitioner for the execution of 3 works executed under DMF Funds Grant in Mallayapalem Village, Ballikurava Mandal, erstwhile Prakasam District, now Bapatla District as illegal, arbitrary and contrary to the principles of natural justice and against the Judgment of this Honble Court in W.P. No. 10038/2021 and Batch dated 05.10.2021 consequently direct the Respondents to release the total bill amount of Rs. 7,93,194/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Ninety Three Thousand One Hundred and Ninety Four only) to the Petitioners account with interest @ 12percentage per annum forthwith and pass
