The representation of the petitioner said to have been addressed to the 2nd respondent dated 13.04.2026 discloses institution of a civil suit in O.S.No.75 of 2026 on the file of Principal Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chilakaluripeta and issuance of notice in I.A.No.409 of 2026 by the trial court. Still the said representation appears to have been submitted to the respondent Nos.2 to 4 apprehending some law and order problem over the issue of Donka/ road in Ramachandrapuram village and the petitioner along with others appear to have requested the respondents to take appropriate action.
