Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in not considering the petitioner's representation dated 02.04.2026 and 13.04.2026 and 27.04.2026 with regard to the illegal not to any action of the respondents to consider the representation in Sy.Nos.182, 183, 176/5,6 of Ramachandrapuram, Murikipudi village and issue prohibitory orders through Hon'ble Tahsildar, Chilakaluripet Mandal as illegal, arbitrary and in violation of

the provisions and consequently direct the respondents to consider the representation dated 13.04.2026 and 27.04.2026 submitted by the petitioner forthwith.

Petition under Section 151 of CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents herein to consider the representation dated 02.04.2026 and 13.04.2026 and 27.04.2026 submitted by the petitioner forthwith, Pending disposal of WP 13655 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI TRIPURAM RAVITEJA Advocate for the Petitioner, and of GP FOR REVENUE, for the Respondent Nos.1, 2 & 4, and of GP FOR HOME, for the Respondent No.3, the Court made the following

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleader seeks time to file counter. ✓

The representation of the petitioner said to have been addressed to the 2nd respondent dated 13.04.2026 discloses institution of a civil suit in O.S.No.75 of 2026 on the file of Principal Civil Judge (Junior Division), Chilakaluripeta and issuance of notice in I.A.No.409 of 2026 by the trial court. Still the said representation appears to have been submitted to the respondent Nos.2 to 4 apprehending some law and order problem over the issue of Donka/ road in Ramachandrapuram village and the petitioner along with others appear to have requested the

respondents to take appropriate action. It is needless to observe that whenever there is any law and order issue, the respondent authorities concerned will act upon the same in accordance with law. If any private parties are disturbing the Donka offending the rights of the petitioner, the petitioner is at liberty to implead them as proper and necessary party respondents to this writ petition. /
