Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for the State.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are arraigned as Accused Nos.1 to 4 in C.C. No.103 of 2025 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Parchur, for the alleged offences under Section 85 of BNS and Sections 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

The learned counsel further submits that the petitioners are the parents of A.1. On account of marital disputes, the petitioners were arraigned as accused in the case, and soon after the marriage, A.1 and the 2nd respondent were living separately, and the petitioners never interfered in their marital affairs.

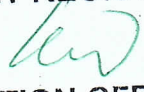
Considering the submissions, there shall be a stay of appearance of the petitioners/Accused Nos.1 to 4 in C.C. No.103 of 2025 on the file of
