The petition/Appeal coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of KUNTAMUKKALA SAI SREE SANJAY Advocate for the Petitioners, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR Advocate for the Respondent and the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

No representation for Respondent No.2.

The marriage of Petitioner No.1 and Respondent No.2 was performed on 24.02.2024. There was a memorandum of understanding on 18.01.2025, wherein it was agreed by the Petitioner No.1 to pay an amount of Rs. 15,00,000/- towards permanent alimony to Respondent No.2 and the said amount was allegedly deposited with the mediation.

But the Respondent No.2 having not satisfied with the amount, she later demanded more money and lodged a complaint against the Petitioners.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, matter is referred to the mediation. Smt. N. Yashodha Kumar, learned trained mediator is appointed as mediator in this case.

Secretary, High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to issue necessary proceedings in this regard.

Both the parties shall appear before the mediation on 04.05.2026
for amicable settlement

Until the mediation proceedings concluded, there shall be stay of
all further proceedings in C.C.No.103 of 2025 on the file of the learned
Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Parchur.
