

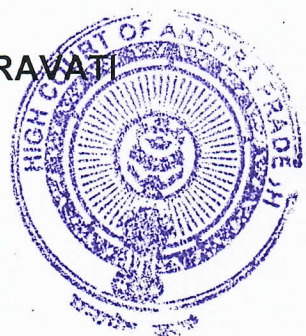

WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri CH S V Suraj presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an Writ order or direction more

particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring action of the 4th respondent Special Cadre Deputy Registrar, District Cooperative Officer, Anakapalli District, issued the Proceeding in Rc.No 181/2025-C (Coop) Dated 02-05-2025 without jurisdiction, and also as per G.O.Ms No 34 , Food and Agriculture (Co-op).IV) dated 18- 01-1989 and section 116-C of A.P.C.S Act 1964 as illegal arbitrary and violation of Articles 14, 21 of the constitution of India and Principle of Natural Justice and consequently Set aside the Proceeding in Rc.No 181/2025-C (Coop) Dated 02-05-2025 issued by the 4th respondent society.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri CH S V Suraj, Advocate for the Petitioner and of GP for Cooperation for the respondent Nos.1 to 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay the Proceeding issued by the 4th respondent in Rc.No.181/2025-C [Coop] Dated 02-05-2025, pending disposal of WP No.13127 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

Learned Government Pleader for Cooperation takes notice for respondent Nos.1 to 4.

Registry is directed to issue notice to respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.5 by Registered Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service into the Registry.

Post on 17.06.2025.

As the petitioner is challenging the initiation of inquiry under Section 51 of the Andhra Pradesh Cooperative Societies Act, 1964, and as it is contended that the Special Cadre Deputy Registrar has no power to initiate the inquiry and as per the provisions of Section 51 of the said Act, the power vests with the Registrar to initiate the proceedings under Section 51, let there be status quo till the next date of hearing.”
