WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his/her Advocate Dr. CHALLA SRINIVASA REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, by declaring the action of Respondent No. 3 (Station House Officer, Machavaram Police Station) in failing and refusing to register an FIR based on the complaint/report dated 19.04.2026, despite the disclosure of cognizable offences, as illegal, arbitrary, malafide, violative of Articles 14, 19, and 21 of the Constitution of India, and contrary to the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Lalita Kumari vs. Government of U.P.; Consequently a) to direct the Respondent No. 3 to immediately register a criminal case against the Respondents 4 and 5 and other who involved in this offence, based on the complaint dated 19.04.2026, investigate the matter, and take action as per law; b) to directing the Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to provide adequate police protection to the Petitioners to recover the stolen furniture, stock, and business documents, and to ensure no further threat to the life and property of the Petitioners; and Pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit/memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Dr CHALLA SRINIVASA REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, GP for Home for the Respondent Nos.1 to 3 directed issue of notice to the

unofficial Respondent Nos.4 & 5 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
