WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate Ms. Y.Bhanusri Akhila presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus to declare the action of 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in addressing letter to 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent directing to freeze the loan Account No. GL32523949 belonging to the husband of the petitioner and consequential action of the respondent No.3 in freezing the loan account of the petitioner bearing loan account No. GL35859977 and clarifying

that the gold ornaments of the petitioner will not be released even after repayment of the entire loan amount unless NOC is issued by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent even inspite of the petitioner not being involved in any criminal case as arbitrary, illegal and violation of Art. 14, 21, 300A of the constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent No.3 to release the gold ornaments of the petitioner after repayment of the entire loan amount and close the loan Account No. GL35859977 without reference of letter dated 30-01-2026 addressed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in the interest of justice;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Ms. Y.Bhanusri Akhila, Advocate for the Petitioner and of GP for Home for Respondent Nos.1 and 2, directed issue of notice to the unofficial Respondent herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
