Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ or order or direction declaring the action of the respondents 7 & 8 in aiding and abetting the 9th respondent to dispossess the petitioner and b) the action of the Respondent No. 5 in proposing to conduct survey on the basis of the application of the 9th Respondent in F-Line petition No. FSNV012600945473 dt:16-04-2026 for fixing boundaries of land admeasuring Ac 3-03 cents in Sy.No.191-1, Settur Village and Mandal, Anantapuramu District and issuing Rc.No.A/19/2013 dt:16-04-2026 requesting the 8th Respondent herein to provide police protection for fixing the boundaries of land admeasuring Ac 3-03 cents in Sy No. 191-1 by LPM No. 833 of Settur Village and Mandal, Anantapuramu District as arbitrary, illegal, unsustainable and direct the respondents 7 & 8 not to dispossess the petitioner from land admeasuring Ac 3-03 cents in Sy No.191-1 by LPM No. 833 of Settur Village and Mandal, Anantapuramu District and further set aside the Rc.No.A/19/2013 dt 16-04-2026 and consequently direct the respondents 4 to 8 not to interfere in civil disputes and aid the 9th Respondent.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents 7 & 8 not to dispossess the petitioners in the garb of grant of police protection for any survey and demarcation proposed to be conducted by the Respondent No. 5 on the application of the Respondent No. 9 in respect of land admeasuring Ac 3-03 cents, Ac 3- 03 cents in Sy No. 191-1 by LPM No. 833 of Settur Village and Mandal, Anantapuramu District, Pending disposal of WP No.13856 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the proceedings issued by the 5th Respondent in RC No. A/19/2013 dt:16-04-2026, Pending disposal of WP No.13856 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent No. 4 & 5 not to conduct any survey pursuant to the application of the 9th Respondent through F-Line petition No. FSNV012600945473 dt:16-04-2026, Pending disposal of WP No.13856 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Prabhakar Peri, Advocate for the Petitioners, and of GP for Home for the

Respondent Nos. 1, 6 to 8, and of GP for Revenue for Respondent Nos. 2, 3 to 5, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Grievance of the Writ Petitioners is that during pendency of the Civil Suit vide OS No.95 of 2015 on the file of the Principal Senior Civil Judge, Ananthapuram and Appeal vide AS SR No.4033 of 2026 on the file of the District Judge, Ananthapuram, respondent No.9 approached the respondent authorities for conducting survey of the subject property vide F.Line No.FSNV012600945473 dated 16.04.2026. Pursuant to which, without considering the pendency of the said Civil Suit and Appeal, respondent No.5 issued proceedings vide RC No.A/19/2013 dated 16.04.2026 for conducting survey, though there is injunction operating in respect of the subject property in OS No.95 of 2015 favouring the petitioners.

Considering the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners, there shall be stay of all further proceedings pursuant to F.Line No.FSNV012600945473 dated 16.04.2026, till the next date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice on respondent No.9 through speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service in the Registry.

Post immediately after Summer Vacation, 2026.

Meanwhile, respondents are directed to file their counter affidavit.
