
Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents not to interfere with petitioners without due process of law including stay of all further proceedings No.52/2026 under Section 318 (3), 318 (4), 351 (2) r/w 3 (5) BNS of PS I Town, Visakhapatnam, Pending disposal of WP No. 13817 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is being listed in the first Vacation Court-2026, as per the orders of the co-ordinate bench of this Court, dated 08.05.2026.

This Writ Petition is filed questioning the action of the Respondents No. 3 to 15 in interfering with civil disputes and extending threats to the Petitioners in respect of property of 6000 Sq.yds in Sy.No.14/1 at Yendada, Chinagadili Mandal, Visakhapatnam without issuing any notice or without following due process of law and to quash



the FIR No.52 of 2026 for the offences punishable under Section 318(3), 318(4), 351(2) read with 3(5) of BNS against the Petitioners.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader, Home for the Respondents placed on record the Written Instructions submitted by the Respondent/ Police, wherein it is stated that they are strictly adhering procedure as prescribed under BNSS and BNS and other applicable laws, as well as principle laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court and also this Hon'ble Court regarding seizure, search, arrest and all consequential proceedings and undertook to take up investigation strictly in accordance with law subject to judicial safeguards.

It is further contended that the allegations are under investigation viz., cheating, criminal intimidation, manipulation of revenue records such as false entries made relating to government land and inducement of purchasers etc., as they are serious in nature, the Respondent/ Police are proceeding with the investigation.

It is further contended that the Writ Petitioners are not co-operating with the Investigating Agency and failed to appear before Authorities as required.

In view of the same, the Respondent/ Police are directed not to deviate from the procedure and adhere the strict procedure as contemplated under the provisions of BNSS and BNS, as well as rulings of the Hon'ble Apex Court and also this Hon'ble Court issued from time to time and the Petitioners are also directed to co-operate with the Investigating Agency and appear before them as and when required.

It is made clear that the Respondent/ Police shall proceed with the investigation without subjecting them undue harassment and that

petitioner shall not abstain from appearing before the Investigating Agency as and when required and shall extend all their co-operation.
