		<p>seizure, search, arrest and all consequential proceedings and undertook to take up investigation strictly in accordance with law subject to judicial safeguards.</p> <p>It is further contended that the allegations are under investigation viz., cheating, criminal intimidation, manipulation of revenue records such as false entries made relating to government land and inducement of purchasers etc., as they are serious in nature, the Respondent/ Police are proceeding with the investigation.</p> <p>It is further contended that the Writ Petitioners are not co-operating with the Investigating Agency and failed to appear before Authorities as required.</p> <p>In view of the same, the Respondent/ Police are directed not to deviate from the procedure and adhere the strict procedure as contemplated under the provisions of BNSS and BNS, as well as rulings of the Hon'ble Apex Court and also this Hon'ble Court issued from time to time and the Petitioners are also directed to co-operate with the Investigating Agency and appear before them as and when required.</p> <p>It is made clear that the Respondent/ Police shall proceed with the investigation without subjecting them undue harassment and that and petitioner shall not abstain from appearing before the Investigating Agency as and when required</p>
