The present Writ Petition is filed declaring the inaction of the respondents 3 & 4 in not taking any disciplinary action against the respondents 5 & 6 in relation to the complaint of the petitioner, dated 16.04.2026, and also not providing C.C.T.V. Camera footage inside the Chebrolu Police Station, Guntur District from 08.04.2026 at 7:46 P.M. to 09.04.2026 till 02:00 A.M. and also the C.C.T.V. footage, on 09.04.2026 between 09:45 A.M. to 3:30 P.M..

The 7<sup>th</sup> respondent – The Sub-Divisional Police Officer, Tenali, submitted written instructions, wherein it is stated that the Investigating Officer – Station House Officer, Chebrolu Police Station, had never kept the petitioners in the illegal custody or ill-treatment during the investigation at Chebrolu Police Station.

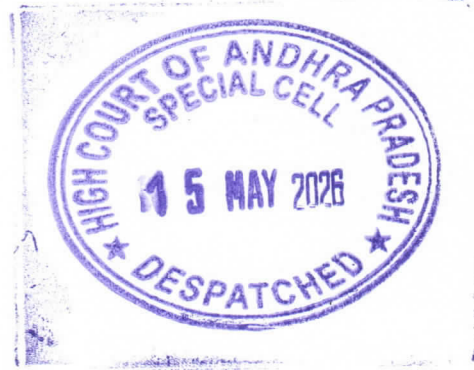
