Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents in repeatedly calling the Petitioner, summoning him without any written notice, threatening, coercing, and interfering with his personal liberty as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional, and consequently direct the Respondents not to interfere with the personal liberty of the Petitioner except strictly in accordance with due process of law, not to summon the Petitioner without issuing written notice under law, not to take any coercive steps against the Petitioner, and not to use, rely upon, or not to uses to any blank signed papers obtained from the Petitioner under coercion;
